

BREEDING CONTRACT

It is hereby agreed to breed the mare \_\_\_\_\_

to the stallion The First Aurora, GGF - TWHBEA #20200009, SSHBEA #10200777, NSSHA #0215047. The fee for such service shall be \$350 for a live foal, due when first breeding cycle is complete. The fee includes the price of pre-breeding palpations/ultrasounds to determine follicle size, and post-breeding palpations/ultrasounds to determine the presence of pregnancy, if performed at Golden Gaits Farm. The fee does not include uterine cultures, biopsies, flushes or hormonal or other medical treatments. Breeder reserves the right to refuse to breed any mare. If this happens, the stud fee will be refunded, minus any board or other expenses. Board for mares shall be at the rate of \$8 per night for a mare without a foal at side, or \$10 per night with foal at side.

Stallion owner or agent shall assume no liability for a mare that will not breed, cannot conceive, or for accident, sickness or death of the mare or her foal.

Stallion owner or agent will try diligently to settle mare and use good judgement in the supervision and care of mare and foal.

Mare owner shall not be responsible for injury or accident to the stallion. Mare owner will be responsible for expenses deemed necessary for the health and/or safety of the mare and/or foal.

Should mare miscarry, abort, or not become settled, the stallion fee will not be refunded, however, the mare owner has the right of rebreeding (and may substitute a different mare) during the current or following breeding season.

Mares not halter broken will not be accepted.

Mare owner agrees to deliver mare in a healthy and sound breeding condition. Mare owner will furnish a current (within 12 months) negative Coggins test for the mare, along with a copy (or copies) of her registration papers, if mare is registered. Mares should have been vaccinated for Encephalitis, Tetanus and West Nile Virus within the last 4 months, and Strangles, Influenza, and Rhinopneumonitis within the last 6 months. Mares should also have been dewormed within the past 8 weeks.

This contract contains a live double-color foal guarantee. A live foal is defined as a newborn foal which stands and nurses without assistance. Return privileges subject to notification within ten days to breeder with a veterinarian's statement confirming death. A double-color guarantee is defined as a foal possessing at least one cream (Cr) gene, and the tobiano spotted pattern. Out of non-dilute mares, a tobiano palomino, buckskin or smoky black will be produced. Dilute mares (cream, double cream, champagne or champagne cream) can produce double dilutes as well as single dilutes. Responsibility for proving absence of the cream gene lies with the foal owner, and will be verified using the cream gene test offered by UC-Davis or Univ. of Kentucky, to be paid by foal owner. Tobiano is defined as at least one white spot no less than two inches in diameter on the body or tail, not including the legs below the line of the body. Return breeding privileges in the event a tobiano dilute foal is not produced are subject to notification of stallion owner, with photographs of mare with foal, within ten days of birth of said foal.

In the event the stallions dies, is sold, or becomes unfit for services prior to breeding the mare, the breeding fee will be refunded, or another Spotted Saddle Horse stallion owned by Golden Gaits Farm will be offered to stud that mare. TWHBEA, SSHBEA and NSSHA registration forms for the foal will be provided by the stallion owner after the birth of the foal if the foal is eligible for registration in these registries. Other registration forms for the foal, provided by foal owner, will be signed by stallion owner if foal is eligible for such registries. No guranatee of gait is made by the stallion owner/breeder. Mare owner agrees to notify stallion owner when foal is born. Mare owner agrees to allow Golden Gaits Farm to use photographs of the foal for advertising purposes.

**TRANSPORTED COOLED SEMEN**

R.J.'s semen survives well during shipping. We will provide shipped semen to the mare owner on the condition the equitainer or equiflight box is returned in good condition within 5 days of receipt of shipment. Mare owner agrees to pay shipping charges to return container to Golden Gaits Farm. Semen will be shipped via Fedex or US Mail overnight only, Monday through Friday. No airline transport is available. Cost to mare owner per shipment is \$100 (includes regular overnight shipping charges to continental US), due before semen is shipped. A minimum of 24 hours notice is needed to ship semen. The stallion owner assumes responsibility to deliver live semen from the stallion in viable condition at the time of delivery to the mare owner. Breeder can not be responsible for the care and handling of the semen after delivery, nor for errors or delays by the carrier company. No refunds after the semen is collected and shipped. Stud fee for shipped semen is payable in full before the first shipment is sent.
